ENGLISH LANGUAGE QUALIFICATIONS

English language colleges in the UK offer preparation courses for prestigious and internationally recognised qualifications. Non-native speakers of English need language qualifications to enroll on a degree course at a British university in the UK. Non-native speakers of English also need language qualifications for many professional jobs in the UK. Sahara in the UK help students prepare for the following English language qualifications:

CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED CERTIFICATE (CAE)

Cambridge offers a range of exams which provide proof of a student's English language ability at different levels. The most popular exams are the Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE) for upper-intermediate level students and the Cambridge Advanced Certificate (CAE) in English for advanced students. Trinity is a widely-recognised examining board that offers Spoken ESOL Exams covering 12 grades, from Beginner to an almost native speaker level of fluency. For more details, please see the sections on General English and Intensive English. The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is an examination run by Cambridge ESOL and the British Council. Students are tested in English reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. Most universities in the UK require



non-native speakers to achieve an IELTS score of 6 or more before being accepted on to a degree course. Professional bodies in the UK (for example, the General Medical Council) also require non-native speakers to achieve an IELTS score before they can practice in the UK. INTENSIVE ENGLISH

2. Receive a decision on the application (usually within one week).

4. Pay a deposit (to be refunded in the last term of study).
5. If the student requires a Tier 4 visa, a CAS will be issued once the deposit has been received (we are not able to issue a CAS more than 3 months before the course start date).

HOW DO I APPLY FOR A MASTERS DEGREE?

Applications are often made online through our website, or directly by sending an email to SSS - although our service provides an admissions service for top universities and colleges. Alternatively, you can usually



download an application pack from Sahara's website or request one by phone, and then apply.

As a starting point, you should contact the Sahara postgraduate admissions office, and explain that you want to submit an application. The admissions team is also your point of contact should you wish to add documents to your application.

Methods of dealing with applications are typically the same across the board. The general admissions department will screen your application and send it to the specific admissions tutor for your particular course, who will then make the final decision.

HOW DO I PUT A PORTFOLIO TOGETHER?

Arts and humanities courses, especially those in areas such as creative writing and fine art, may require you to submit a portfolio. This demonstrates your work, your

commitment, abilities, creativity and personality. It should contain a range of your best and most recent work, explaining how it's been crafted through investigation and reference materials. Sketchbooks and notebooks should be included, as these highlight your independent research skills and creative process.

Organise your portfolio chronologically or in topic groups. There's usually no limit to what you can include, but keep numbers sensible as you'll often have to transport your portfolio to an interview. Each individual programme will have specific requirements. Some may ask you to submit your portfolio digitally - this could be in the form of a slideshow, CD-ROM or DVD.

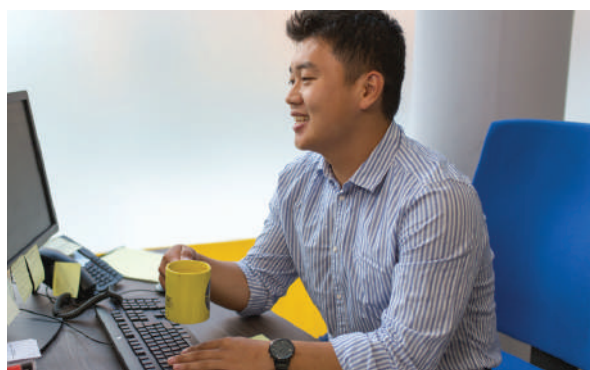


HOW DO I WRITE A RESEARCH PROPOSAL?

Research proposals can form the basis of your research Masters degree. You must articulate exactly what you want to research and why. While word limits vary, research proposals are usually 500-1,500 words in length.

How interesting and relevant your idea is will determine how easy it will be for you to cope with what lies ahead. We propose using the following template when composing your research proposal:

- Introduction - What is your study about?
- Aims and objectives - What do you want to achieve, and how will you achieve it?
- Theoretical literature - What existing theories or models are you going to use?
- Contextual literature - What is the sample population that you're going to collect data from?



- Research gap - Why is this project interesting, and how will you fill the knowledge gap?
- Methodology descriptor - How will you collect and analyse data?
- Provisional timetable - How are you scheduling your project?
- Possible research impact - How will your research revolutionise your field?



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I'VE APPLIED?

The most common outcomes are:

- Unconditional offer - You've met all of the entry requirements and have a confirmed place on the course.
- Conditional offer - You're being offered a place on the course, provided that you meet certain requirements.
- Interview - You must attend an interview before a final decision is made.
- Unsuccessful - You've failed to gain a place on the course.

WHAT DOES A PHD INVOLVE?

A standard PhD is typically split into three stages. By way of illustration, a three-year PhD may follow the following pattern:

- **First year** - You'll meet with your supervisor to discuss your research proposal and agree an action plan with deadlines. You'll then complete your literature review, in which you'll evaluate and critique existing works to inform the direction of your project and ensure that your research will be original.
- **Second year** - Your focus will shift to gathering results and developing your thesis, and potentially begin writing chapters of your thesis. You may also present your results and ideas at academic conferences, gain teaching experience, collaborate with other students on similar projects, communicate the benefits of your research to the general public through workshops, lectures and presentations, or submit work for publication in an academic journal or book.

- **Third year** - This phase primarily involves writing your thesis, though your primary research may still be in progress. After your supervisor gives their approval, you'll submit your thesis before undertaking a one-to-three-hour oral exam (viva voce) in which you'll discuss and defend your thesis in the presence of at least one internal and external examiner.

HOW DO I WRITE A RESEARCH PROPOSAL?

Your Research Proposal

Your research proposal must passionately articulate what you want to research and why, convey your understanding of existing literature, and clearly define at least one original question and your approach to answering it. Research proposals are usually 1,500-3000 words in length. While it must be well-structured, your research proposal should retain sufficient flexibility to comfortably accommodate any changes that you need to make as your PhD progresses.

Layout and formats vary, so it's advisable to consult your potential supervisor before beginning. Here's what most research proposals include...

1. Title page

Your provisional title should be around ten words in length, and clearly and accurately indicate your area of study.

The title page should also include personal information, such as your name, academic title, date of birth, nationality and contact details.

2. Aims and objectives

This is a short summary of your project. Your aims should be two or three broad statements that emphasise what you ultimately want to achieve, complemented by several focused, feasible and measurable objectives.

3. Literature review

This section discusses the most important theories, models and texts that surround and influence your research questions, conveying your understanding and awareness of the key issues and debates. It should also focus on the theoretical and practical knowledge gaps that your work aims to address, as this ultimately justifies and provides the motivation for your project.

4. Methodology

This section outlines how you'll answer each of your research questions. A strong, well-written methodology is always crucial, but especially so if your project involves extensive collection and significant analysis of primary data.

The methodology identifies the data collection and analytical techniques that are available to you, before justifying the ones you'll use in greater detail. You'll also define the population that you're intending to examine. You should also show that you're aware of the limitations of your research, qualifying the parameters that you plan to introduce. Remember: it's more impressive to do a fantastic job of exploring a narrower topic than a decent job of exploring a wider one.

5. Timetable

Concluding or following on from your methodology, your timetable should identify how long you'll need to complete each individual step - perhaps using bi-weekly or monthly timeslots. This helps the reader to evaluate the feasibility of your project.

6. Bibliography

Finally, you'll provide a list of the most significant texts.



How do I prepare for a postgraduate interview?

Many postgraduate courses ask applicants to attend an interview as part of the selection process. Knowing how to prepare and perform well at these can make all the difference.

Refresh your understanding of the course and university, so you can clearly articulate why you chose to apply there. You should also ensure that you're familiar with everything you wrote in your application, and explain how you'll pay for the course and where you plan to live. You should also think about any questions that you have for them. You can't be 100% sure what you'll be asked. However, there are a number of topics that you can safely assume will come up.

- Academic interests - this could include why you chose your undergraduate degree, why you chose your dissertation topic, and what modules you enjoyed and performed well in. You want to show genuine interest in your subject, and how what you've studied so far has prepared you for studying at a higher level.
- Academic knowledge - this is something you'll have to prepare for.
- Career goals - explain how you plan to become successful and be as specific as possible. Set yourself goals for the next five or ten years.
- Experience - if the course is relatively vocational, the interview may focus more on your experience than on your academic background.
- Funding - tell the interviewer what funding measures you have in place.
- Reasons for choosing the course and university - show that you've researched the institution and course, explaining how it has impressed you.
- Strengths and weaknesses - list your best skills and provide evidence. If asked about your weakness, mention one attribute that you're looking to develop.

A private room will generally be allotted, while spaces such as kitchen and lounge area will be shared in an apartment of anything between 4-8 fellow students. All bills, including wi-fi, are included in your rent.
